Agenda Items & General Business

1. End of Year Show

Raffle - a big thank you to Irma, Gill and Sally-Anne who have offered to organise local experience vouchers for the raffle. We will also gather non-perishable items from our skating families to make up a couple of hampers. Agreed that we should draw the raffle prizes just after the half-time interval to encourage everyone to get back to their seats before the second half.

Costumes - May needs a hand with sorting these out for the show. She will get possible weekend dates from Janine to organise a 'working bee' at Janine's house (where the costumes are stored).

Helpers - an email has gone out. Please respond to May asap regarding how you can help if you haven't done so already.

Door Entry Donations - we discussed again at length where any profits should go as we had originally discussed it would be great to give to a local children's charity. The committee all agreed that we should first ensure we cover our costs to put on the show and any surplus will be used as gym rental subsidy, making it more affordable for our skating families.

Fiona C gave an update on where this is at after her meeting with Zane from Sport BOP regarding a Community Funding application. She will send the info to May to distribute with these Minutes. Zane has recommended we make a small contribution towards the Needs Assessment Study to demonstrate our genuine interest. We agreed to put \$100 towards this.

She will put together a list of all the jobs she currently does as secretary so that these can perhaps be distributed between other committee members and recruit a new secretary.
