Business

Gym bookings have been changed to accommodate the new dates for Areas. David to check the Learn to Skate booking for Friday 16 April and cancel it, if not already done. **Friday 9 April** will be the end of term Fun Skate. **Term 2** bookings will need to be done by Monday 1 February, to start on the first Monday of Term 2, no skating Queen's Birthday weekend (5-7 June).

Learn to Skate – David will take the two competition skaters classes following Learn to Skate; Janine and Ngaire, with new coaches, Maegan and Hunter, will run Learn to Skate. An honorarium for coaches discussed and agreed \$75 per term, direct credited to bank accounts.

Adult classes – May has received requests for these. Queries

who would run them
would there be enough people to cover the cost
they would need their own skates.

It was decided to redirect people to Skateschool Tauranga, where there are two-hour sessions on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Federation registrations need to be done before medal tests for new skaters. Photo IDs are required for this.

Oceania/Worlds – nominations are sought for managers and coaches. David is not wanting nomination.

April School Holiday Practices – as Areas is the first weekend of the holidays, it was suggested that skaters and parents have some time off, After some discussion it was decided there would be no skating over the holidays.

Show – this is booked for 16 October. Janine will book Sportsdrome for a rehearsal.

Competition Practices – these are booked at the Sportsdrome, 9 am to 1 pm on Saturdays 20 March, 10 April, 22 May, 19 June and 3 July.

Tuesday Practices are booked from 7-8 am for Seniors and some groups on the following dates:

4, 11, 18, 25 May

6 July.

Medal Tests – coaches will be emailed and will need to notify May of candidates – name, artistic number, federation number, test/s to be taken.

Areas Manager – as Fiona is stepping down, Janine will continue in this role with Sandra assisting. Fiona will be available for advice. David will be the club's official coach for the competition.

Funding – this is needed for the show, plus one or two other, targeted, items. Janine suggested funding for costume storage and everyone is asked to look for possible sponsors to assist with hiring a storage unit. The Funding Committee will obtain a quote for a unit (Clare to follow up).

Renting out costumes is a possible source of funds. Photos and a catalogue will be needed for the club's facebook page. A thorough stocktake will need to be done (as costumes are put into storage, perhaps?).

May will obtain a quote for 2022 costumes.

Show

- * show theme was suggested as 'Around the World', using the existing boat and 'Mr Body'.
